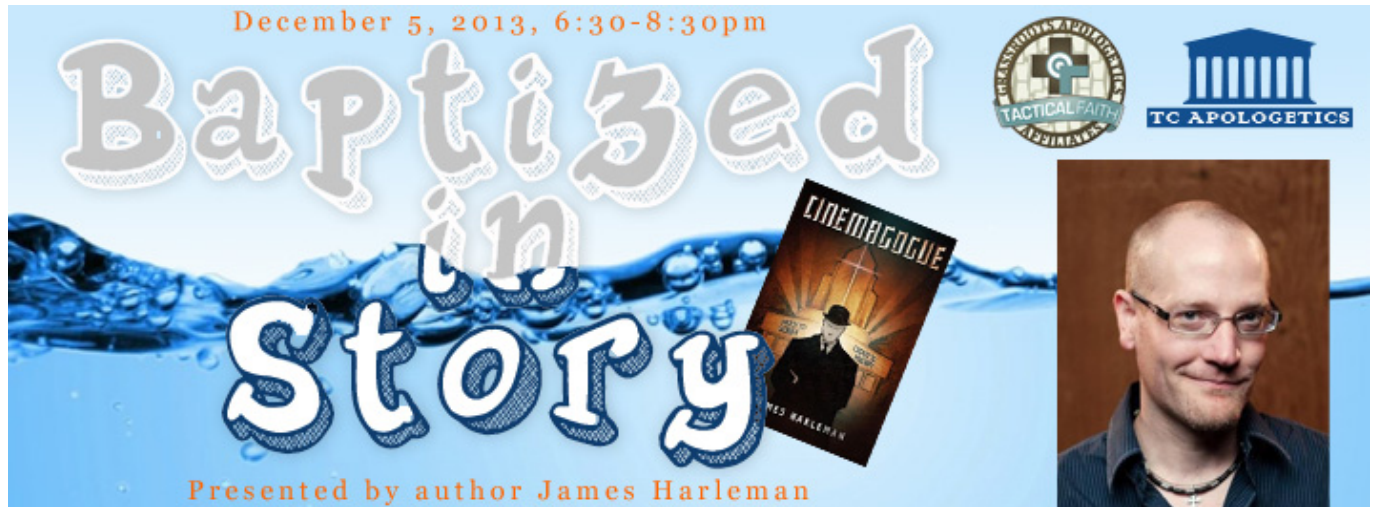


[TCA Hangout: James Harleman](#)
